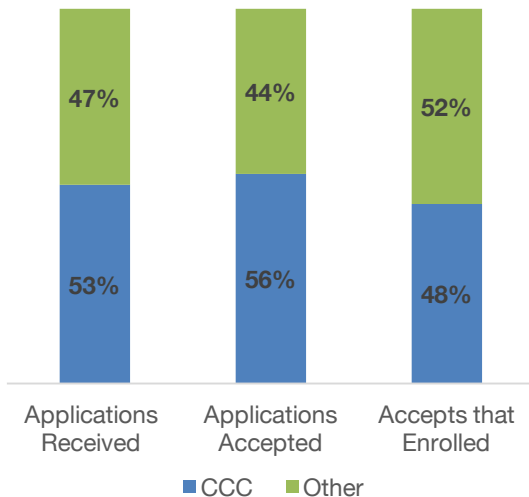
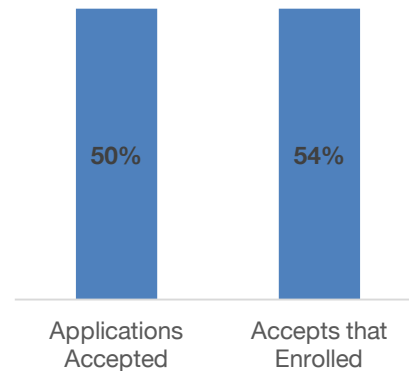


Enhancing Communities Through Higher Education

AICCU surveyed its undergraduate serving institutions (70) on their 2015-16 enrollment cycle. Out of the 70 institutions, 44 (64%) completed the 2016 AICCU Undergraduate Admissions Survey.

On average AICCU institutions saw an increase of 10% in applications from students at a CCC. This is double the overall average increase (5%) in all applications received from prior year.

All Transfer Applications to AICCU Institutions


Responding AICCU institutions received over 24,800 transfer applications for the 2015-16 academic year. Of those, the majority were from California Community College (CCC) students. Seventeen of the 44 institutions have formal transfer agreements and/or other unique partnerships with community colleges through the state.

Of all applications that were received for the academic year 2015-16, 50% were accepted. Of those who were accepted, 54% enrolled.
