

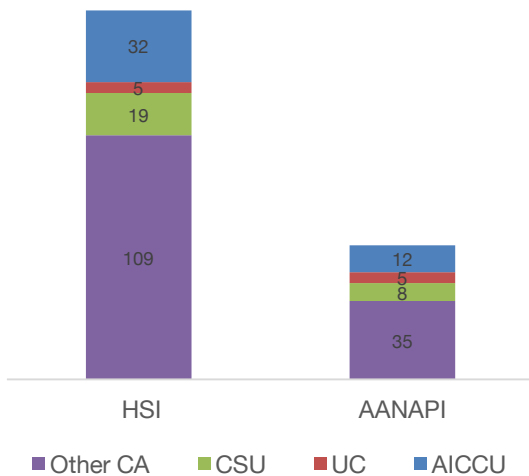


Commitment to Federally Designated Programs

The core mission of AICCU institutions is to improve lives through higher education. Institutions are incredibly diverse and committed to the public good, including programs to help increase access to underserved groups.

Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSI) have an enrollment of undergraduate full-time equivalent (FTE) students of at least 25% Hispanic students. Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander-Serving Institutions (AANAPI) are institutions that have an enrollment of undergraduate students that is at least 10% Asian American and Native American Pacific Islander.

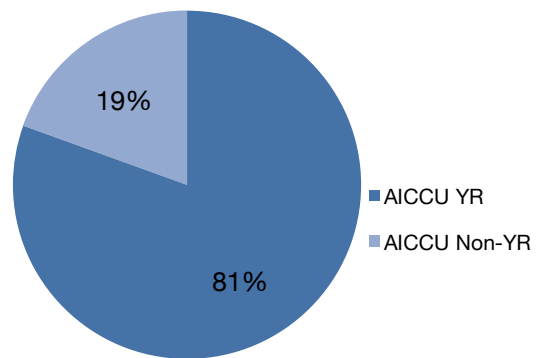
HSI and AANAPI Institutions in California



Of all 79 AICCU institutions, 40% are HSI and 21% are AANAPI serving institutions.

AICCU institutions also actively participate in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Yellow Ribbon Program. The Yellow Ribbon Program is the post 9/11 GI Bill lowering the actual tuition and fees per academic year at a private institution. Private institutions that participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program agree to make additional financial aid available for the Veteran's education.
