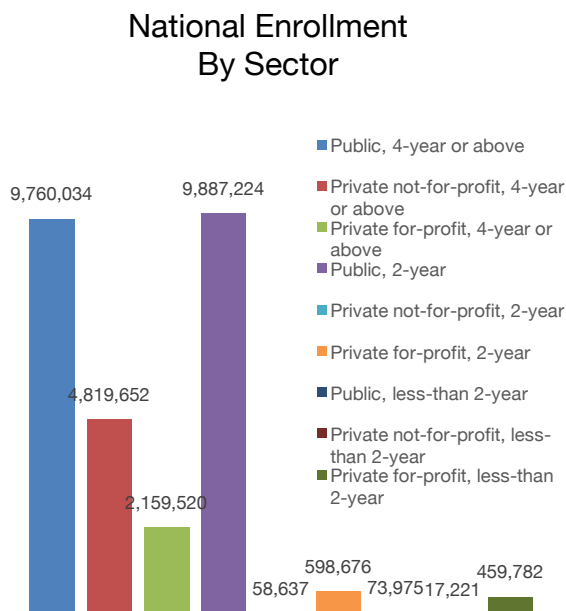


## California: Leading Enrollment in Higher Education

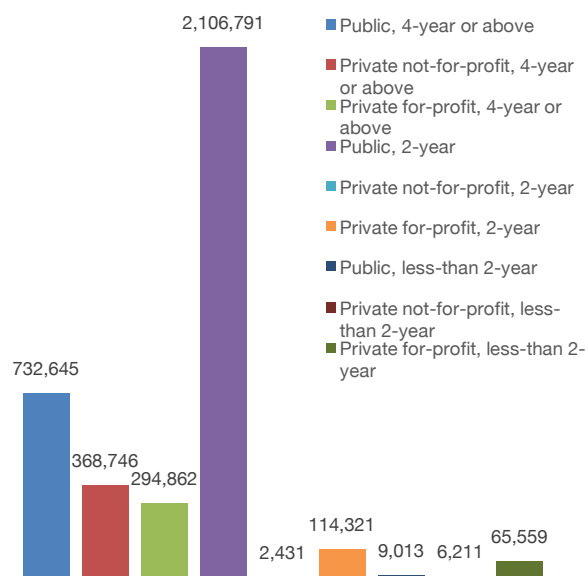
In 2013-14, across the nation there were over 27 million students enrolled in postsecondary institutions (all sectors). California enrolled over 3 million students, or 13% of all students in postsecondary institutions.

Nationally, private nonprofit 4-year institutions enroll 17% of all students. The public 2-year and 4-year institutions combined enroll 70% of students. The remaining 13% of the students were enrolled in a private for-profit, private nonprofit 2-year or less, or a public less-than 2-year institution.



In California, private nonprofit 4-year institutions enroll 10% of all students, while the public 4-year institutions enroll 20%. California community colleges enroll the most students at 57%.
