



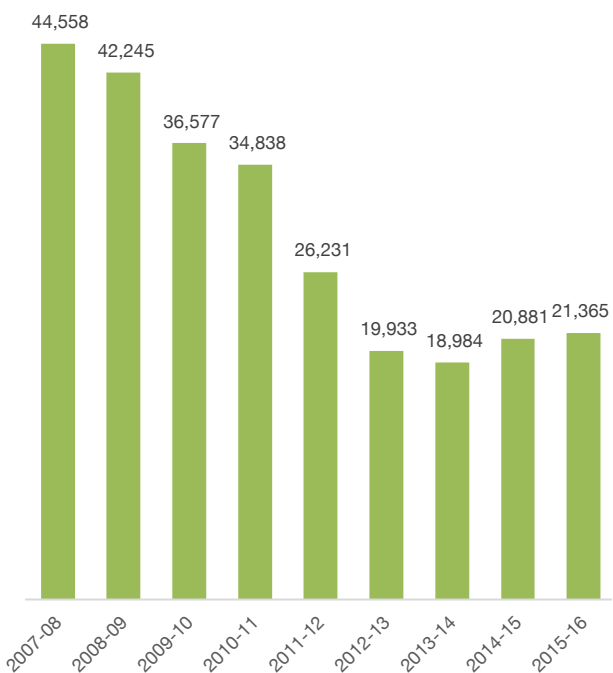
Keeping the Promise to Teacher Preparation Education

The California Commission on Teaching Credentialing (CTC) reports annually to the Legislature and Governor, with its [Teacher Supply in California: A Report to the Legislature Annual Report](#).

The report provides information on past and current teacher supply in the state.

From 2007-08 to 2013-14, California experienced a decrease in total teacher preparation enrollment from 44,558 to 18,984. In 2014-15 California experienced its first increase in over 7 years, reaching 20,881. California experienced another increase in 2015-16 to 21,365.

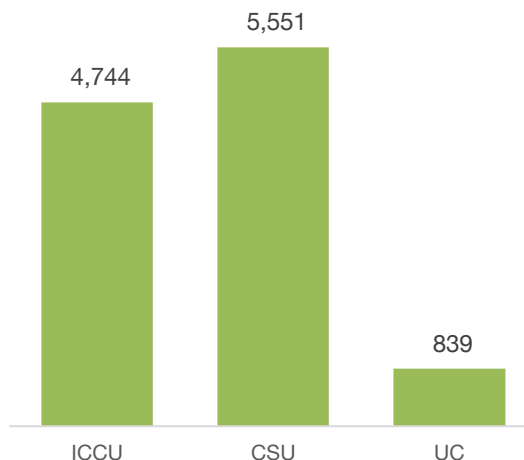
Total Teacher Preparation Enrollment

Independent California colleges and universities (ICCU) are committed to preparing California’s teacher workforce. Of the students in a teacher preparation program in 2015-16, 55% were enrolled in an independent college or university. 39% were enrolled in a CSU.

Of the new teacher credentials awarded in 2016-17, 43% were awarded at an ICCU institution.
